

**Independent Study Title** Educational Administration of Baan Chulabhorn Pattana  
2 Child Development Center under Khao Phra  
Subdistrict Municipality, Phipun District, Nakhon Si  
Thammarat Provincial Administration Organization

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### Abstract

The research objectives were: 1) to study the educational administration of Chulabhorn Pattana 2 village's Child Development Center, Khao Phra Municipality, Phipun District, Nakhon Si Thammarat Province. 2) Problems and suggestions of the educational administration of Chulabhorn Pattana 2 village's Child Development Center, Khao Phra Municipality, Phipun District, Nakhon Si Thammarat Province. The study population consisted of teachers, caregivers, the head of the Child Development Center, Cooks, Cleaners, and parents of children, totaling 54 people. The research tool is a questionnaire on the educational administration condition of Chulabhorn Pattana 2 village's Child Development Center. It is a 5-level Rating Scale and an open-ended questionnaire on problems and suggestions. The data were analyzed through averaging, standard deviation, and content analysis.

The results of the research revealed that:

The overall state of educational administration of Chulabhorn Pattana 2 village's Child Development Center was high ( $\mu = 4.07$ ,  $\sigma = 0.57$ ). When considering each aspect, in descending order of averages, the highest averages are jobs, participation, and community support at a high level ( $\mu = 4.15$ ,  $\sigma = 0.62$ ), followed by academic work and curriculum-based activities at a high level ( $\mu = 4.13$ ,  $\sigma = 0.64$ ). Furthermore, the lowest average was personnel and management work at a low level ( $\mu = 4.09$ ,  $\sigma = 0.63$ ).

Problems and suggestions of the educational administration of Chulabhorn Pattana 2 village's Child Development Center, Khao Phra Municipality, Phipun District,

Nakhon Si Thammarat Province. Overall problems are that all personnel work in many fields, parents do not have time, and there is a lack of play equipment for children. The suggestion is to plan a system for working as a team. Seek support for teaching materials/equipment from the community and public relations for student parents/guardians' cooperation.
