

Independent Study Title Mobilization of educational resources in basic education institutions under Surin Primary Educational Service Area Office 1

Abstract

The objective of this research was to study the mobilization of educational resources in basic education institutions under Surin Primary Educational Service Area Office 1. The sample group was 337 basic education institute administrators and the chairman of the educational institutes. The instrument used for data collection was a 5-level estimation scale questionnaire with a confidence value of .93. The statistics used in the data analysis were percentage, mean, standard deviation. The hypothesis was tested by T-test and one-way ANOVA analysis. When the mean difference was found, the pair test was performed by the Scheffes method. The results showed that;

1. The results of the analysis of resource mobilization, overall and individual aspects of educational administration, was at a high level. When considering each aspect, it was found that the highest average aspect was management, followed by materials-equipment, and the lowest average aspect was HR.

2. A comparison of resource mobilization for overall educational administration and each aspect classified by respondent status, overall and individual aspects, classified by respondent position found that in terms of material resources - equipment and management resources, there were statistically significant differences at the .05 level.
