

Independent Study Title: Relationship between Community and School Administrators in Schools under Surin Primary Educational Service Area Office 1

Abstract

The objectives of this study were to study and compare the relationship between community and school administrators in schools under Surin Primary Education Service Area Office 1. The sample group was 330 teachers and chairman of the board of Basic Education Institutions in school under Surin Primary Education Service Area Office 1. The instrument used for data collection was a 5-level estimation scale questionnaire with a confidence value of .92. The statistics used in the data analysis were percentage, mean, standard deviation. The hypothesis was tested by F-test. The results showed that;

1. The Relationship between Community and School Administrators in Schools under Surin Primary Educational Service Area Office 1, overall, was in a high level. When considering each aspect, it was found that the highest average aspect was the service to the community, followed by the participation in community activities. The lowest average aspect was the public relations for educational institutions.

2. The comparison of the Relationship between Community and School Administrators in Schools under Surin Primary Educational Service Area Office 1 classified by position of the respondents, overall and in each aspect, is not different. It was not different by position experience, too. When considering each aspect, it was statistically significant at the .05 level all aspects except for community participation in educational institution activities.
